Access for All

Access for All is a free, 300-hour construction trades training program that prepares you for a rewarding career in the construction industry. Access for All provides support for basic needs such as transportation and childcare, and a small stipend for expenses during the training. Graduates earn credentials in OSHA 30, First Aid/CPR, and Asbestos, Lead, and Silica Awareness, and a nationally recognized certificate from North America's Building Trades Union (NABTU). Wayne State Guarantee

The Wayne State Guarantee is open to all Pell Grant-eligible Michigan residents, as well as most families who earn \$70,000 or less and have \$50,000 or less in assets. The WSU Guarantee will cover the full cost of tuition and standard fees (matriculation, registration, and student service fees) with a combination of federal, state, and other WSU scholarships and grants.
