Community Resources

September is Library Card Sign-Up Month

5 reasons why you should sign up for a library card this month!

1. Borrow books from libraries outside of Detroit
2. Get discounts at museums and state parks
3. Use the computers and printers at a local branch. Printing fees are 10 cents per page for black and white or \$1 for a page in color.
4. You can watch movies and tv shows using the streaming platform Hoopla or have access to e-books, magazines, and audio books with the app Libby for FREE.
5. Library card holders 18 and over can reserve a laptop and Wi-Fi-hotspot for up to 90 days by calling 313-481-1400 or visiting any branch.

Sign up for a card at any local Detroit Public Library branch.

MoGo Free Rides

MoGo will be holding FREE RIDE DAY on the third Thursday of every month through October!

Riders can get a pass at MoGoDetroit.org, through the [Transit app](#), or at a station kiosk by selecting the 'Free Ride Pass'. Every ride can last up to 60 minutes – unlike the Prepaid Pass, unused minutes will expire at the end of the day.

While there is no cost to ride, there will be an \$8 hold placed on that individual's credit card or bank account that will be returned within 72 hours of Free Ride Day.

Focus Hope Great Start Readiness Preschool

Great Start Readiness is a preschool program for four-year-olds.
